Do you feel safe at Somerdale Educate Together Primary school?	Additional Learn Together session outlining how the school keeps children safe and what ways children can report to senior leaders if they are worried about anything.

Additional Learn Together sessions to focus to support children identify 5 safe adults. Also to focus on additional support mechanisms including Wilbur the Worry Monster and Childline.	
Do you know where to find the Anti-Bullying Charter?	Listening Team to run additional sessions with the Anti-Bullying ambassadors to ensure all children know where to locate and use the Anti-Bullying charter.

How could we improve Somerdale Educate Together Primary School?

We would like a longer breaktime	Our school break and lunchtimes meet the time allocated by the government. If we increase the time further you would miss learning time.
We would like more play equipment	We are working with FOSET to fund raise for new play equipment. At the moment we are on Phase 4. You will notice there have been a range of new equipment recently purchased including the three-way shooter, den poles, sports cupboard. In the next year we will continue to purchase new equipment.
We would like football nets	We already have small football nets for the playground. We will ensure they are available on a lunchtime.
we would like more time in the pond area	We will discuss this with the teachers and ensure that each class gets a set number of visits during each academic year.
