Understanding of the school behaviour policy in relation to challenging behaviour.	8	External and internal reviews of behaviour at Somerdale is very good. Classroom observations demonstrate that children are focused and on task. Behaviour around the school is purposeful. Children understand the school rules which are linked to the behaviour and relationship policy. During the 2024-25 academic year we consulted with the school community (including the children) to develop an updated Respectful Relationships & Behaviour Policy which was ratified by the governing board (July 2025). Challenging behaviour in the school is rare, but when it does happen there are clear protocols which are followed. This is outlined in detail in Section G (Consequences & Sanctions) of the school behaviour policy. What Do you like about Somerdale Educate Together Primary School?

- It is a great learning environment, and the school really encourages community connections.

- I love the friendly and welcoming atmosphere at Somerdale. It's such a joy to see how happy my children are there and how wonderful the teaching staff are. My children have flourished at the school so far, and I look forward to seeing how their learning and personal skills develop throughout the rest of their time at Somerdale.
- I love the fact that the ethical curriculum is teaching my children to be nice people and to understand how privileged they are. I can see the school does an excellent job of instilling kindness and fairness into my children. The staff are all extremely friendly and have a good rapport with my children. The awards system works really well and my children love being recognised at assemblies. The staff are clear at parent's evenings where my children are doing well and where they need to improve.

- There is a strong emphasis on including other elements in their education that helps develop them into rounded individuals rather than just focusing on academic achievements. The environment feels inclusive and safe and I know both of my children would feel comfortable approaching any member of staff if they had a concern or question.
- My child always comes out happy, so I know they are being treated fairly and in a kind manner. The outdoor provisions for preschool and reception are great.
- The school is a very inclusive school and makes sure that everyone's views are taken into account. I can see that several parents help out at school which feels and adds to the inclusivity. It is easy to talk to teachers about concerns and planning to help your child.
