

Key vocabulary	
Town	A place where many people live. It has homes, shops, schools and roads.
Village	A small place where fewer people live. It has houses, a few shops or a church.
City	A large place where lots of people live. It has many buildings, shops, schools and transport.
Urban	place with lots of buildings, roads and people (like a town or city).
Rural	A place with more countryside, farms and open space. Fewer people live there.
Human feature	Something made or built by people (like a house, road or playground)
Physical feature	A natural thing (like a river, hill or tree)
Map	A drawing of a place from above
Aerial photo	A photo taken from the sky
Compass	A tool that shows direction: North, East, South and West
Map symbol	A small picture or sign that shows something on a map (like a church or river)
Tourist	Someone who visits a place for fun or interest

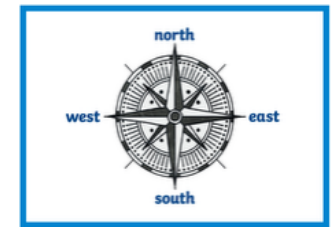

Key knowledge:

- Human features are made or built by people. Physical features are natural.
- Keynsham is a town between the cities of Bath and Bristol.
- A town is a place where many people live, work and go to school. Towns have shops, schools, parks, transport and places to visit.
- Villages are smaller than towns. Cities are larger and more built up.
- Compass directions help us describe where things are.
- Map symbols are small pictures or signs that show important things on a map (like a church, river or school).
