## In your new classroom...



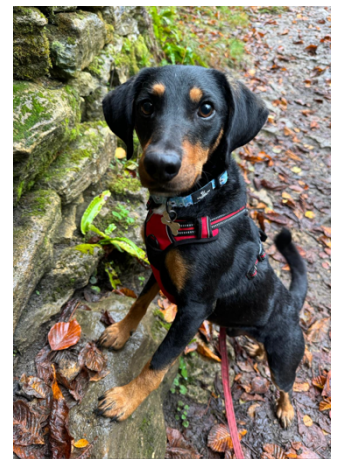
You will find lots of things to help you with your learning. We have different areas for different parts of your learning, like our maths, writing, enquiry and creative stations.
